**SUBJECT: ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION AT CITY OF BURNABY FACILITIES -
WARNING #2**

Please be advised that this letter is the second written warning regarding Ultra Soccer and the consumption of alcohol at City facilities during the Spring/Summer 2016 season.

Staff observed members of your league consuming alcohol on field #3 at Burnaby Lake Sports Complex West at 9:30pm on Sunday, August 28, 2016 after the game scheduled from 7:00-9:00pm. The teams were identified as the Port Moody Boozehounds and Arcoiris FC. Staff informed players of the no alcohol policy and asked that they leave the facility. Arcoiris FC left immediately while the Port Moody team continued to drink and slowly exited the facility. One Port Moody team member wearing a black jacket with the initials MK stopped to urinate in the bushes close to the practice field and water fountain with a female staff person close by. The staff member informed the player that the washroom was close by and asked that he use it in the future.

At present, we are considering not permitting the Port Moody Boozehounds to use City of Burnaby facilities in the future based on their non-compliance and offensive behaviour. Our facility is used by many youth sport groups and should not have to be exposed to adults urinating in public. Please contact me at your earliest convenience to discuss the next steps with this team.

The executive of Ultra Soccer is required to address the violation with both teams and ensure that all teams in your league are informed of the policy. A letter from the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services outlining the City of Burnaby's rules and regulations regarding alcohol consumption at Burnaby parks and facilities and the City's "Code of Conduct" are enclosed. The City of Burnaby's rules and regulations regarding alcohol consumption are also contained in the Sport User Guide that was provided when the Ultra Soccer representative received the allotment contract. These documents clearly state that it is illegal and the City will not tolerate this activity.
